"Copyright Limitations and Exceptions for Libraries and Archives"

Access to knowledge is the key to socio-economic development in all countries around the world. Without access to information for personal, educational, social, business, political, individuals would not develop or enhance research and knowledge. The libraries play a key role in providing access to knowledge, learning and fostering creative ideas leading to innovative society or preserve the world's cumulative knowledge and heritage for future generations. The unique role of libraries is shaped by copyright law through balancing the interests of authors and creators by granting certain monopoly rights and through limitations and exceptions on the use. These, exceptions for libraries and Archives are fundamental to the structure of copyright law throughout the world, and the exceptions play an important role in facilitating library services in serving the social objective. The Copyright Act also provides authors to transfer their rights to publishers in order to bring their works to market. Negotiations for an International regime on Exceptions & Limitations for Libraries and Archives are in progress in Standing Committee on Copyright and Related Rights of WIPO.

The advancement in the digital age and the easy availability of copyrighted material within the premises of the libraries and the technology's impact on the creation, dissemination and protection of works and of productions protected has raised many concerns.

Objective of the Workshop - The underlying objective of the Workshop is to present to the public, academic, special, and school librarians the opportunity to learn about intricacies of Copyright Law and its limitations and exceptions on the facilities availed through the libraries and in Archives. Participants in the workshop will develop a better understanding of the law and learn how to balance the rights of authors and creators with the needs of the end users.

Themes of the Workshop - The Workshop intent to discuss on the issues of the Copyrightable subject matter, Rights of the Author, Publishers & end users, and also the impact of digital technology on Copyright regime with a major concentration on Copyright Limitations and Exceptions to Libraries and Archives.
