SCHEDULE

The list of offences upon arrest under which a DNA sample may be lawfully collected from the arrested person without his consent:

1. Any offence under the Indian Penal Code, 1860 if it is listed as a cognizable offence in Part I of the First Schedule of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973;

[Alternatively, all cognizable offences under the Indian Penal Code may be listed here]

- 2. Every offence punishable under the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956;
- Any cognizable offence under the Indian Penal Code, 1860 that is committed by a registered medical practitioner and is not saved under section 3 of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971;

[Note that the ITP Act does not itself create or list any offences, it only saves doctors from prosecution from IPC offences if certain conditions are met]

- 4. Every offence punishable under the Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994;
- The offence listed under sub-section (1) of section 31 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005;
- 6. Every offence punishable under the Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955;
- 7. Every offence punishable under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.
