**Sub: Posting of Government employees who have children
with hearing impairment or multiple disability**

The undersigned is directed to say that there has been a demand that an employed parent of a child suffering from hearing impairment or multiple disability may be given posting to their own preferred linguistic Zone or State where educational facility for their hearing impaired or multiple disabled child exist and that too in the same language exists. This demand has been made on the ground that the disabled children may have opportunities of learning in the single language, as these children cannot cope up with learning their subjects in more than one language, as a result of transfer of their parents from one State to another.

2. The matter has been examined. Considering that the facilities for medical care and education of children with hearing impairment or multiple disability may not be available at all stations, such requests from the parents of a child suffering from hearing impairment or multiple disability, may as far as possible, be considered sympathetically. Where, however, this may not be possible, efforts may be made to accommodate such a Government servant in the same State to the extent possible. All the Ministries / Departments, etc are requested to bring these instructions to the notice of all the appointing authorities under their control.

**Sub: Acceptance of Legal guardianship provided under
National Trust Act, 1999 for grant of family pension to
mentally retarded son/daughter of a railway servant.**

In terms of proviso to Rule 75(6) of Railway Services (Pension) Rules, 1993 as amended vide Gazette Notification No. F(E) III/94/PN1/31/Amendment dt. 3.2.1995 and No. F (E) III/99/PN1/38/Modification dated 23.5.2000, family pension for life in respect of mentally retarded son or daughter shall be payable to a person nominated by the railway servant or to the pensioner, as the case may be, and in case no nomination was furnished to the Head of Office by such Railway servant or pensioner during his / her life time, to the person nominated by the spouse of such Railway

servant or family pensioner, as the case may be, later on. In case no nomination was filed by the Railway servant or the pensioner, as the case may be, or by the spouse or family pensioner later on, family pension in respect of mentally retarded son or daughter shall be paid through the guardian, as if he/she were a minor, on the basis of guardianship certificate, or the guardian appointed by a Court.

2. Instances on non-acceptance by certain Zonal Railways of the guardianship certificate issue by the Local Level Committee headed by the District Collector constituted under the National Trust Act, 1999 for the Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities, have come to the notice of Board. Board desire that in those cases where the Railway servant or the pensioner or the spouse, of the family pensioner, as the case may be, did not nominate a person to receive family pension for life in respect of his/her mentally retarded son or daughter, family pension may be sanctioned and released through the person in favour of whom Legal Guardianship has been provided duly stating the purpose as for receipt of family pension, by the Local Level Committee, a statutory body constituted under the National Trust Act, 1999, without insisting on guardianship certificate from a Court.
