**ORDER**

For the purpose of extending maximum possible facility for the treatment of  
persons with disabilities and also for removal of discrimination of the disabled  
employees in compliance with the provisions of Persons with Disabilities (Equal  
Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 the following  
order is issued after careful consideration of the matter relating to the posting of  
disabled employees together with the legal grardians of the disabled dependents.

The posting and transfer of the following categories of employees under the  
administrative control of Women & Child Development & Social Welfare Department,  
Government of West Bengal will be made to such places which are nearest to their  
respective homes at the Choice of the employees concerned subject to the  
practicability of such posting from the view point of administration :



1) All employees who are disabled as per provisions of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995.

2) Parent of dependent physically or mentally handicapped offspring belonging to moderate or above categories.

3) Legal guardians of the dependent physically or mentally handicapped persons belonging to moderate or above categories.

This Order is also issued in consonance with the Memo No. A-B 14017/41/90- Estt. (RHQ) dated 10. 5. 90 of Government of India in the Department of Personnel and Training under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension. This Order should be implemented with the utmost care by all the authorities control the transfers and postings of the employees.
