(PR) dt. 15.2.1991 from Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel Public Grievance & Pension, Deptt. of Personnel and Training and the Govt. of W.B., women & Child Development and Social Welfare Deptt.'s endorsement to all Deptt.'s of Govt. of West Bengal with the request to make suitable departmental order, Deptt. of Jails. Govt. of West Bengal has decided to issue the undermentioned order.

The posting and transfer of the following categories of employees under the administrative control of the Deptt. of Jails, Govt. of West Bengal will be made to the working place nearest to their respective family at the choice of the employee concerned provided there is any scope for the purpose.

- i) Parent of dependent physically or mentally handicapped offspring belonging to moderate or above categories.
- ii) Legal guardian of the dependent physically or mentally handicapped persons belonging to moderate or above categories in case the latter's parents are not alive.
- iii) Working handicapped employees belonging to moderate or above categories. Henceforth, this order should be implemented with utmost care.
